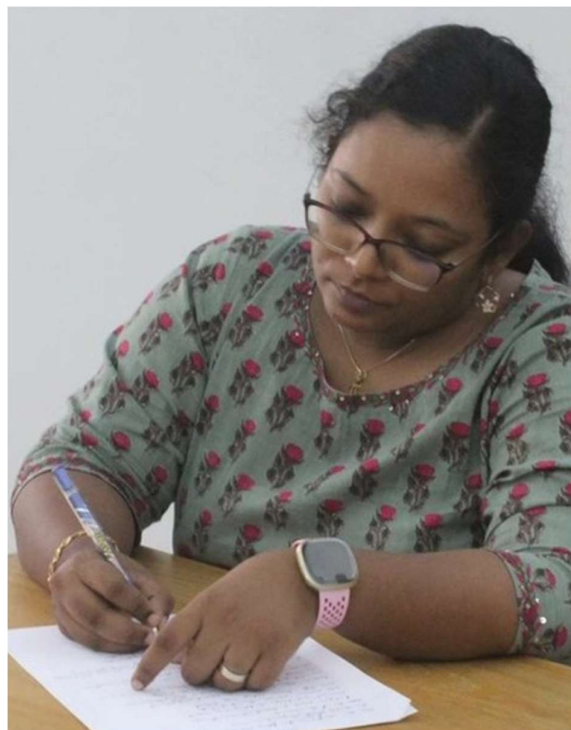
SOAP CARVING
